

## ALSG Sweden

PKMC, Prehospital and Disaster Medicine Centre, is assigned by Region Västra Götaland to carry out courses in disaster medicine and psychosocial care. PKMC is also one of Sweden's five training centers in disaster medicine.

Since 2004 ALSG Sweden has been a part of PKMC. ALSG Sweden carry out, in agreement with ALSG in Manchester, national and international courses according to the systems developed by ALSG. The courses are all intensive, includes lectures and skills and are based around tried and tested methods.

## Our courses



### MIMMS, Major Incident Medical Management and Support

The practical approach at the scene, principles for medical services and management of a major incident. The course is held completely in Swedish with course material translated into Swedish. Courses in English may occur. MIMMS is provided as a three or one day course.

### MedicALS, Acute Medical Emergencies

Handling of above all, acute internal medical emergencies. The three day course is held in both Swedish and English with instructors from Sweden and Great Britain.

### APLS, Advanced Paediatric Life Support

Acute care of seriously ill or injured children. The three day course is held in both Swedish and English with English course literature.



### Instructor course, MIMMS, APLS and MedicALS

Generic instructor course for candidates recommended for instructor status on the above mentioned courses. A three day course held entirely in English with instructors from Great Britain. The course includes key note sessions, demonstrations and practice sessions in all six modalities of teaching and assessment required for life support training; lecturing, skills teaching, closed discussions, scenarios and skills/scenario assessment.



### Instructor course, Triage at the scene

An easy way to quickly carry out triage at the scene, according to the MIMMS-principles, with help from a special triage tag now available in Swedish. Half-day course in Swedish.
